General Electric PVM9179 Convection Microwave Oven is designed for installation over a range. This is a roomy 1.7 cu ft. convection oven that includes a 1,000 watt microwave. It features microwave cooking, convection baking, warming and FastBake

via either manual or automatic baking controls, an automatic range ventilation fan (outside top exhaust or re-circulation) and a range light. Consumer ratings are very high and there are many favorable reviews.



### **Size**

The inside of the oven is 21-5/9 inches wide by 9-6/15 inches high by 14-1/4 inches deep. That's 1.7 cubic of space inside the oven.

The exterior is 29-7/8 wide by 16-1/4 inches high by 15-1/2 inches deep.

# **Controls**

One of the cool features of this model is a rotating dial that is used to make selections by turning the dial and pressing the dial to enter the selection. I love this simple and effective way to select and enter settings. The dial selects settings such as time, temperature, power level and more. The dial is much easier than pressing a series of buttons that is required on many ovens. Hats off to GE for including the dial. The dial reduces the number and variety of touch pad keys required. Other setting are entered on the familiar touch pad.

Lock Controls - The control panel can be locked to prevent accidental starting. I think it is a handy feature that should be set during cleaning as well.

# **Finish**

There are four exterior finishes to pick from: Bisque (biege), White, Stainless Steel, and Black. The interior is stainless steel.

### GE Profile Microwave Installation

The General Electric PVM9179 Convection Microwave Oven is a GE Profile product designed to match other GE Profile products. This unit is designed for over the range microwave installation. It can be installed over a range no wider than 36" that is either electric or gas (less than 60,000BTU's). It comes with a wall mounting plate and instructions. This unit fits under a 30 inch cabinet nicely.

There is available at extra cost a matching filler panel kit (JX40WH - White & JX41 - Black) for use when when replacing a 36" range hood. A word of caution; this is not for end of panel installation.

# Display

There is an easy to read three line display at the top of the control panel. There are two large rows and one smaller row at the bottom of the display. The language displayed can be changed and there is a setting to change the speed that information is displayed.

# Cooking Options

Manual microwave cooking (select power & time). Sensor microwave cooking. Manual convection preheat, cook and broil. Automatic mix (microwave and convection) bake, roast and broil. Multiple sequence cooking using using both microwave mode and convection mode, including switching from one to the other.

- Some consumers report that the display is confusing

"The only fault I find with it is that the convection preheat is a bit slow. It takes a while to get up to temp, especially if you need hotter than 350."
